



Music At Your Wedding

Congratulations on your upcoming wedding! Music at your ceremony can add a mood of elegance and dignity, in addition to enhancing the ceremony itself. The couple should plan to schedule a consultation meeting with our Director of Music, Trystan Bennett, at least **six weeks** prior to the wedding date in order to select music for the wedding.

In keeping with the heritage of our historic church and the sacred nature of your Wedding Ceremony, music must be selected from the rich repertoire of music suitable for Church weddings, as determined by the Director of Music. Our Director of Music serves as organist for all weddings and an outside organist may be used only by permission from our Director of Music, or in the event that he is unavailable on the selected ceremony date.

Any outside organist must meet with our Director of Music briefly to familiarize themselves with our wedding policies and use of our instrument. If our organist is unavailable for the selected date, an experienced substitute will be provided and introduced to the couple for planning purposes as early as possible. Our Director of Music will also make every effort to attend your Wedding Rehearsal, but can not guarantee availability.

Arrangements for additional vocal or instrumental musicians may be made in consultation with our Director of Music. We will be happy to assist you in finding suitable soloists for your ceremony, but booking and payment details must be arranged directly with those musicians unless otherwise agreed upon with the Director. Our organist fee is \$200 and includes a consultation meeting, the wedding rehearsal (if available) and the ceremony itself.

Musical selections at your wedding may include:

- ◆ Prelude & Seating Music
- ◆ The Procession of the Parents & Grandparents (*optional*)
- ◆ The Procession of the Wedding Party
- ◆ The Procession of the Bride
- ◆ Opening Hymn (*optional*)
- ◆ Gradual Hymn (*optional*)
- ◆ Closing Hymn (*optional*)
- ◆ Wedding Recessional

If your wedding is to include Communion, you may also want to consider including:

- ◆ Offertory or Offertory Hymn
- ◆ Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy)
- ◆ Agnus Dei (O Lamb of God)
- ◆ Communion Hymns
